The Syro-Malabar Eparchy of Great Britain has its origin in the small groups of people who gathered to celebrate the Syro-Malabar Holy Qurbana. The eucharistic communion has become the basis of our ecclesial communion, in the very same way the Church flourished in the Apostolic times.
